

Again, this month our numbers were lower than in 2023, granted 2023 was the busiest year on file for the police department. As you can see, we are down on calls for service citations and arrest. Please don't think that our job is only chasing numbers. If we are doing a good job, numbers should at some point begin to decrease. We strive to be very visible to the community, more hours on patrol!

In January we abated the properties off Allspice. It took some time to find someone to mow/brush hog the property. I have contacted a brush hog company, and he will be completing that very soon. It will cost \$300.00, his minimum, weeding eating is included.

For the month of March, we have really focused on Inoperable Vehicles. I have advised all officers to contact every residence that has, by city ordinance, an inoperable vehicle on their property and either make contact or leave a form on their door. Attached is a copy of the form The form includes the city ordinance. We are giving each resident the opportunity to remove the vehicle or to get it operational in 14 days. After 14 days we will issue citations on a case by case basis. Those that have several vehicles maybe give more time, those that decide not to act will be cited. After the first citation we will give them five more days to remove/fix, if still not compliant we will issue a second citation. Then three days later go through the process again. After that time, we will begin issuing citation daily until compliance. As of today, 3/7 we have contacted 29 residences with a total of 48 inoperable vehicles.


Since we started this process, we have had five individuals come in and complain, stating that the police department is just dealing with individuals that are not on city council. Each of the five that have complained have compared their yard to Aldermen Jim Campbell's. These five people stated they felt like if the police department was going to fix the problem it needed to start with the Aldermen, Jim Campbell. Three of the five advised they would be at city council, 03/12/2024. We encouraged them to attend and to make a report to the council. Officer Byerley received an anonymous complaint on 01/19/2024 in reference to Mr. Campbell's property, that letter is attached to this report. Mr. Campbell's tow company is located at 263 N. Oak Ave. The GIS mapping shows Mr. Campbell owns three different parcels, His home and business at 263 N. Oak Ave, an empty lot to the north that does not have a GIS address and a third parcel located adjacent to the south with the address of 239 N. Oak Ave. Mr. Campbell has told me, the vehicles setting on the lot of 239 N. Oak are his personal vehicles. As of today, 03/07/2024 there are 10 inoperable vehicles, per city ordinance, located on the property at 239 N. Oak.



You are being sent this notice because you have been identified as potentially having an interest in the property at 189 Walnut Street. As per **Section 050.060** of the Sparta Municipal Code, a notice has been issued to all other interested parties including owners, lessees, occupants, mortgagees, and agents.

The building at 189 Walnut Street was condemned on September 12th 2023 and notice was sent out September 25th 2023. Per the Order of Condemnation, the vacation, demolition, and cleanup of the property has not been completed in the thirty (30) days' time. If action is not taken by 3:00 p.m. March 9th 2024 the abatement of the property will begin. The hearing is set for March 12th at 6:00 p.m. during the Regular Board of Alderman Meeting.
